



# New art-works by women artists

The art-works were made by women artists.  
The women artists were born between 1930 and 1991.  
The women artists come from Europe and the USA.  
Some art-works in the exhibition are old.  
The oldest art-work is from the year 1967.


The women artists use different methods.  
They make sculptures from materials like metal, leather, or textile.  
They take inspiration from architecture,  
**for example** from a staircase or a windmill. 


They use objects from everyday life and change them.

### The women artists create their art-works:

- With their hands.
- With tools.

They make, **for example**, a piece of textile with a loom.

# The topics of the exhibition

The women artists work with things from the past.

**The topics of the exhibition are:**

- Everyday life and where we live.

**What is everyday life?**  
**Everyday life means:**  
How something normally is for regular people.

- How we use technology.
- Big changes in politics.
- Art from the street.  
**For example:** posters, graffiti, ...

The women artists criticise important topics from their time.

**For example:**

- People buy too many products.
- Problems in society.  
**Society means:** Different people live together in a place.
- People destroy nature.  
They can be a danger to nature.

The women artists think about how these things can be changed.

# West Gallery:

In the West Gallery there are **5 televisions** on the floor.  
On the televisions are 5 videos by the artist **Diana Thater**.  
**Diana Thater** was born in 1962 in San Francisco, USA.

She is interested in animals and nature.  
Her videos show an invented story.

The story is **not** real.  
In the story, the thoughts of a girl go into the head of a monkey.

Diana Thater wants us to think.

**For example** about:

- Wild animals and pets.
- Nature and technology.
- Human and animal.
- Human and nature.



In the gallery there are **5 suit-cases**.

That is an art-work by the artist **Zoe Leonard**.

**Zoe Leonard** was born in 1961 in New York, USA.

You **cannot** see what is in the suit-cases.

The suit-cases have different sizes and colors.

Friends and family of Zoe Leonard gave her the suit-cases.

They used the travel bags for travelling.

Different suit-cases are broken and dirty.

Zoe Leonard shows us things from everyday life.

She wants us to see things in a new way.



# East Gallery:

In the East Gallery there is an art-work made of black cubes.

The art-work is by the artist **Eva Kot'átková**.

She was born in 1982 in Prague.

Prague is the capital city of the Czech Republic.

The Czech Republic is a country in Eastern Europe.

**Her art-work is called:** 'Controlled Memory Loss'.

On the cubes are small models of houses.

On the wall are pictures, drawings and collages.

You see people who are locked inside the houses.

**There are many rules in society, such as:**

- How to behave.
- How to live alone.
- How to live together.

In the Czech Republic there were many rules before.

Even today there are many rules.

Some rules can lock people in.

Just like the walls of an apartment.





In the gallery stands a metal staircase.

It is very big and goes from the floor to the roof.

It is curved and deformed.

It looks like a disaster broke it.

That is an art-work by the artist **Monika Sosnowska**.

She was born in 1972 in Ryki, Poland.

The name of the art-work is: 'Stairway'.

The art-work looks like a fire escape.

**What is a fire escape?**

A fire escape is a staircase.

It is often made of metal.

It is outside of a house.

It is for emergency exit.

The artist saw a similar staircase in Tel Aviv.

Tel Aviv is a city in Israel.

The artist is interested in architecture.
